REQUEST FOR UTILITY TAP CONNECTION AGREEMENT

The City of Gerald provides water and/or sewer service to over 1,300 citizens located both inside and outside of its city limits and the safety and security of the city's utility systems is extremely important.

The purpose of this agreement is to protect the drinking water supply from contamination that could result from improper construction/configuration of private water distribution systems; and notify and ensure that each customer is aware and agrees to the requirements and restrictions on each customer.

By executing this agreement, Applicant (Customer) agrees to the following:

1. There will be no cross connection between the public water system, a private water supply system (well), or other potential sources of contamination shall be permitted. Potential threats of cross contamination shall be eliminated at the service connection by either removal of the meter or an approved air gap between the city and private (other) water supply source.
2. The customer shall immediately remove the adequately isolate any potential cross connections or other potential contamination hazards on his/her premises.
3. The applicant must provide plat or scale drawing of property to be served showing:
 - a. Desired location(s) and size for water meter(s).
 - b. Description of premises to be served.
4. Prior to covering any portion of the work, the Gerald Public Works Department must be notified when the private service line(s) are ready for inspection and connection to the city utilities. The City of Gerald will make all utility connections to the water main.
5. The City of Gerald will verify that check valve/backflow preventer has been properly installed between private service line and the City of Gerald utility connection to the water main.
6. Customer agrees to be responsible for exposing the city main at the tap location. The size of the exposure must be adequate size and depth in plain view to a depth of 6 inches below the bottom of the service main to allow installation. All work to be performed to OSHA Standards.
7. Customer acknowledges that the City of Gerald is not responsible for maintaining or providing a specified pressure or flow at the connection; and Customer will be required to and responsible for high or low pressures in their service line.
8. Customer will be required to and agree to install a pop-off overflow valve or backflow preventer on sewer line.
9. Customer agrees to submit or abide by any and all water rationing adopted by the City of Gerald. Failure to abide by any water rationing resolutions or orders may result in IMMEDIATE TURN OFF OF ANY SERVICE CUSTOMER HAS WITH THE CITY OF GERALD, to include, but not limited to the removal of the water meter.
10. For meters greater than 1", refer to attached specification and detail. City of Gerald Public Works Department must approve and accept proposed meter, and installation will be made upon acceptance of meter and verification of payment to utilities department.
11. Customer agrees that any new line extensions will be built to City Specifications and will be subject to approval of the City Engineer. APPROVAL IS REQUIRED PRIOR TO ANY WORK BEGINNING.

Chapter 700. General Provisions

Section 700.190. Application For Sewer And Water — Tap Fees And Deposits.

[R.O. 1996 § 700.190; Ord. No. 450 §8, 8-12-1999; Ord. No. 634 §1, 5-8-2008; Ord. No. 657 §1, 5-14-2009]

- A. Generally. All persons applying for or accepting utility service does thereby express his/her assent to be bound by the rules and regulations that may be in effect now or later pertaining to any and all City utilities and the public health in general.
- B. The following fees shall be for tapping into the City water and sewer main lines:

- C. Water. The fees in Subsection **(B)** for installing three-quarter (3/4) and one (1) inch lines shall cover all materials and labor to the property line, but not more than sixty (60) feet, including pipe saddle, corp stop, pipe, and curb stop with curb box; inside meter with backflow device and outside reader, or copper setter with backflow device, meter, meter look, frame and cover. Pipe or tubing shall be copper or copper tube size PVC, not less than three-quarter (3/4) inch diameter or less than one hundred sixty (160) psi pressure test.
- The fees in Subsection **(B)** for one and one-half (1 1/2) and/or two (2) inch water lines covers only the labor necessary for such installation to the curb stop only. Any additional cost of necessary material or additional labor shall be in addition to the tap on fees listed in Subsection **(B)** as determined by the City Public Water Division and calculated using the actual cost to the City for such material and additional labor.
- D. Sewer. The fee set out in Subsection **(B)** covers all material and labor to the property line, but not more than sixty (60) feet, including sewer tapping, saddle, pipe, and cleanout access to the building sewer line at or near the property line. Minimum pipe and coupling standards shall be SDR 35.
